The employee must submit the certificate of enrolment (specific certificate for educational leave issued by the school) to his employer by 31 October of each school year at the latest. <a href="#">KMO-Portefeuille</a>	Flanders	The SME e-wallet is oriented towards practitioners of 'liberal professions' and SMEs whose operational headquarters are located in the Flemish Region. <a href="#">Vlaams Opleidingsverlof</a>	Flanders	Under certain conditions, employees in the private sector are entitled to Flemish training leave. They are allowed to be absent from work to attend training, while their wages continue to be paid. The employee can be reimbursed a lump sum as compensation for the wage costs.	The employer must submit an electronic request within three months of the start of the training to request reimbursement from the Flemish Government through the counter of the Werk Department for Social Economy. You pay half of this, the Flemish government pays the other half. You will therefore receive a compensation of a maximum of 125 euros per school year. ### Tax Deductibility & Scholarships

<p><b>Tax Deductibility in Belgium</b></p> <p>Expenses incurred by a taxpayer are deductible as professional expenses only to the extent that they were incurred during the taxable period to acquire or retain taxable income. He must also justify the reality and the amount by means of supporting documents or, when this is not possible, by any other means of proof admitted by common law.</p> <p>The general rules should be applied and therefore a distinction should be made between:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>costs incurred in order to follow a training course related to the activity carried out (eg acquisition of a specialization) in which case the costs incurred are deductible. This covers not only registration fees but also all other training-related expenses: e.g. course material, travel expenses, etc. ;</li> <li>the costs incurred in view of a career reorientation. Considered to be expenses of a personal nature, these expenses are not deductible.</li> </ul> <p>The practice of justifying real professional costs is therefore only interesting if their amount exceeds the flat rate.
