<a href="#">Regio Educational Leave</a>	<a href="#">Congé-éducation payé</a>	Brussels	Paid educational leave allows workers (private sector) to train during the day or in staggered hours, while retaining their salary. Employers receive reimbursement from Brussels Economy and Employment, based on certain criteria.	The Region's reimbursement to the employer is limited to a single lump sum of 21.30 euros per hour.	The employee must submit the certificate of enrolment (specific certificate for educational leave issued by the school) to his employer by 31 October of each school year at the latest. <a href="#">Regional Financial Aids</a>	<a href="#">KMO-Portefeuille</a>	Flanders	The SME e-wallet is oriented towards practitioners of 'liberal professions' and SMEs whose operational headquarters are located in the Flemish Region.	The SME wallet is a web application through which entrepreneurs can obtain €7,500 subsidy each year, supporting their further professionalization. <a href="#">Regio Educational Leave</a>	<a href="#">Vlaams Opleidingsverlof</a>	Flanders	Under certain conditions, employees in the private sector are entitled to Flemish training leave. They are allowed to be absent from work to attend training, while their wages continue to be paid. The employee can be reimbursed a lump sum as compensation for the wage costs.	The employer must submit an electronic request within three months of the start of the training to request reimbursement from the Flemish Government through the counter of the Werk Department for Social Economy. <a href="#">Regional Financial Aids</a>	<a href="#">Opleiding Cheques</a>	Flanders	You are an employee or you work as a temporary worker. You live in Flanders/Brussels or you work in Flanders. You follow the training on your own initiative and pay for it yourself.	You can purchase a training voucher per school year for an amount (= nominal value) of up to 250 euros. You pay half of this, the Flemish government pays the other half. You will therefore receive a compensation of a maximum of 125 euros per school year.	Request your training voucher via the WSE counter. The training voucher.
